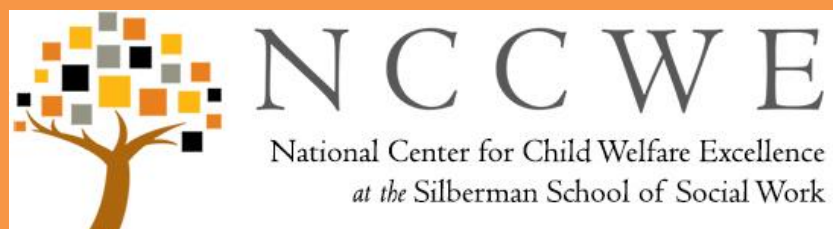

## Instructions for preparing a presentation

There are two ways in which you can prepare your presentation:

- (a) PowerPoint Slides *OR*
- (b) PowerPoint Posters

Both should follow the content guidelines below. Presentations should be in English.

To create a PowerPoint poster, follow the steps:

1. Visit [http://www.makesigns.com/SciPosters\\_Templates.aspx](http://www.makesigns.com/SciPosters_Templates.aspx)
2. Select a PowerPoint poster **template** (use 36"x48" template size).
3. Modify as needed and insert your project information to showcase your proposed content.

## Content to include (but not limited to)

PowerPoint Slides should contain the following information in each slide.

PowerPoint Posters should contain the following sections on the poster.

- **Title** of project/paper.
- **Background/Summary** of literature review.
- **Methods** (if research project) – Clearly stated research question/area of inquiry; Clear description of methods used to address question/area.
- **Findings/Conclusions** – This may reflect findings or conclusions from a research study or other relevant information.
- **Discussion** – Relevance of topic to child welfare (children, youth, and families) practice, policy, research and/or education.
- **Conclusion** – Implications for Social Work practice, policy, research and education.

### \*Evaluation criteria for selection to participate

Proposals will be reviewed for

- Quality/clarity of writing
- Quality of literature review
- Originality
- Relevance to the field of children, youth, and families
